



IMPORTANT NOTICE

In order to improve attendance across the school, particularly of children with persistent absence and term time holidays, Brightwells Trust Board and the Local

Governing Body of the school, have decided that from September 2018 Penalty Charge Notices (PCNs) will be issued. A PCN is a fine given to parents or carers of children who miss school without good reason. The school will make a decision as to whether a referral to Early Help is made for a child with poor attendance, or whether to refer to the Local Authority. It is then up to the Local Authority to decide which course of action to take (which may include a warning, some support with attendance or a PCN). Leaflets providing more information are available in the lobby.
