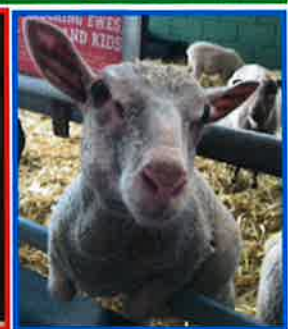

A—May—Zing!!!! Year 6 have done it again and have aced their SATs results. If you look at the table, you will notice the column labelled 'disaggregated'—compare these results with the national percentages and you can see that we have achieved higher than national in all subjects and in combined scores for reading, writing and maths (RWM). These results highlight how well the children in the mainstream have achieved this year (results from children attending the SEN unit have been removed). EXS means children achieving expected standard; GDS results relate to children achieving at greater depth (higher level). The column labelled 'published' is what this DfE and national newspapers will report and what you will see on comparison websites. You will notice these results are lower because these include children attending the unit. Queen's Manor is in the unique position in LBHF as no other school has to disaggregate scores in this way. As such, comparing nationally published data, pitting QM against other schools really doesn't make any sense. Parents and friends, shout it from the rooftops and be really proud - QM is the place to be, we work really hard—achieve amazing results and we're a big family! Super high fives to Year 6 and the Year 6 staff team—we really are so proud of you.
