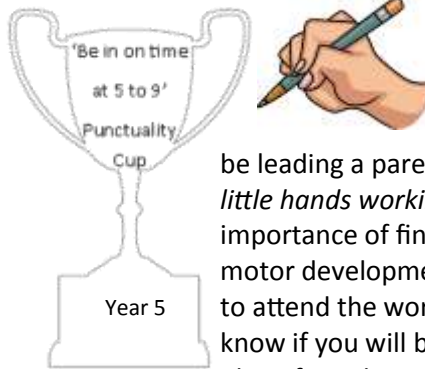
OH NO THEY DIDN'T!
